## **DECEPTION**

The Garden reflected the character of God, but since original sin our world portrays the character of its god of whom Jesus said, "He was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the truth, for there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies." (John 8:44 niv)
